**REGULATIONS UNDER THE FEES REGULATION ACT, 1927**

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Fees Regulation (Education) Regulations, 1990*.

**Interpretation**

2. (1) In these regulations—

"**authority**" means an authority granted by the Teachers Registration Board under section 63(1) of the *Education Act 1972*;

"**Government school**" has the same meaning as in the *Education Act, 1972*;

"**registration fee**" means the fee for registration as a teacher prescribed by the *Teachers Registration Regulations 1975*, as in force from time to time (not including any additional assessment fee prescribed by those regulations for the purposes of such registration);

"**Teachers Registration Board**" has the same meaning as in the *Education Act 1972*.

(2) For the purposes of these regulations, a student is to be regarded as a full fee paying overseas student if—

(a) the student holds a temporary entry permit in force under the *Migration Act 1958* of the Commonwealth;

and

(b) the Commonwealth and the State disregard the student (or a class of students to which that student belongs) when calculating the amount of any assistance to the school at which the student is enrolled.

**Fees**

3. (1) The following fees are payable to the Minister by a full fee paying overseas student for tuition at a Government school:

(a) years 8 to 12—

(i) for the second semester of 1998 . . . . . \$4 000

(ii) for 1999 and each subsequent year . . . . . \$8 000

(b) full year intensive English course—

(i) for the second semester of 1998 . . . . . \$4 500

(ii) for 1999 and each subsequent year . . . . . \$9 000

- (c) single subject course—
- (i) for the second semester of 1998 ..... \$ 425
  - (ii) for 1999 and each subsequent year ..... \$ 850

(2) If a full fee paying overseas student receives tuition at a Government school for part only of a year, the Minister may reduce or waive the fee in respect of that year (or, if the fee has been paid, refund all or part of it) having regard to the length of the period of tuition.

**Application fee for authority**

4. (1) The following fees are payable to the Teachers Registration Board:

- (a) on application for a Long Term authority for a period ending on the 31st day of January last occurring before the expiration of three years from the grant of the authority ..... the registration fee plus a non-refundable assessment fee of \$50.00
- (b) on application for an extension of a Long Term authority for a period of three years ..... the registration fee
- (c) on application for a Short Term authority for a maximum period of 12 months ..... one-third of the registration fee (rounded up to the nearest dollar).

(2) Subject to subregulation (1), the Teachers Registration Board may, where it considers reasonable cause exists for so doing, remit any fee imposed under this regulation in whole or in part.
