Legislative history

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Public Corporations (Lotteries Commission—Tax and Other Liabilities) Regulations 1997*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Interpretation

In these regulations—

Act means the *Public Corporations Act 1993*.

4—Application of section 29 to the Lotteries Commissions

- (1) Section 29 of the Act applies to the Lotteries Commission of South Australia.
- (2) Subject to a determination of the Treasurer under section 29 of the Act, subregulation (1) operates so as to impose liabilities on the Lotteries Commission of South Australia under that section—
 - (a) with respect to a liability to land tax—from 30 June 1997;
 - (b) with respect to other liabilities—from 1 July 1997.
