The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure (State Planning Policy) (Biodiversity) Amendment Act 2017*.

2—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016*

3—Insertion of section 62A

After section 62 insert:

62A—Biodiversity policy

The Minister must ensure that there is a specific state planning policy (to be called the *biodiversity policy*) that specifies policies and principles that are to be applied with respect to enhancing biodiversity and minimising adverse effects of development on biodiversity within the State.
