Crown Lands (Resumption of Dedicated Land) Proclamation 2003

under section 5AA(1)(c) of the Crown Lands Act 1929

Preamble

The following land is dedicated as a reserve for school purposes, not intended for ecclesiastical or denominational purposes (*Gazette* 6.12.1962 p1587):

Allotment 4037, Town of Whyalla, Hundred of Randell, being the whole of the land contained in Certificate of Title Register Book Volume 5733 Folio 649

2 The registered proprietor of the land has requested the resumption of the land.

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Crown Lands (Resumption of Dedicated Land) Proclamation 2003*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Resumption of dedicated land

The land defined in the preamble to this proclamation is resumed.
