National Parks and Wildlife (Para Wirra Conservation Park) Proclamation 2016

under section 30(1) of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *National Parks and Wildlife (Para Wirra Conservation Park) Proclamation 2016*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made immediately after the *National Parks and Wildlife (Para Wirra Recreation Park) Proclamation 2016* comes into operation.

3—Constitution of Para Wirra Conservation Park

The following Crown land is constituted as a conservation park and assigned the name *Para Wirra Conservation Park*:

Sections 178, 179, 180, 181, 182, 183, 184, 185, 199, 216, 217, 237, 238, 299, 311 and 342, Hundred of Barossa, County of Adelaide;

Allotment 1 in Deposited Plan 58800, Hundred of Barossa, County of Adelaide;

Sections 275, 277, 278, 279, 280, 396, 423, 428 and 429, Hundred of Para Wirra, County of Adelaide;

Allotments 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 in Deposited Plan 58801, Hundred of Para Wirra, County of Adelaide.
