The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Casino (Enclosed Areas) Amendment Act 2011*.

2—Commencement

- 5 This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

3—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of *Casino Act 1997*

10 4—Insertion of Part 4 Division 1A

After Part 4 Division 1 insert:

Division 1A—Gambling only allowed in enclosed areas

27A—Gambling only allowed in enclosed areas

- 15 It is a condition of the casino licence that gambling may only take place under the licence within a place or area that is enclosed as defined by the *Tobacco Products Regulation Act 1997* (see section 4(3) and (4)).
