The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Civil Liability (Solatium) Amendment Act 2006*.

2—Amendment provisions

- 5 In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of *Civil Liability Act 1936*

3—Amendment of section 28—Liability to parents of person wrongfully killed

Section 28(1)(a) and (b)—delete paragraphs (a) and (b) and substitute:

- 10 (a) if the death occurred before the commencement of the *Civil Liability (Solatium) Amendment Act 2006*—not exceeding \$3 000; or
- (b) if the death occurred after the commencement of the *Civil Liability (Solatium) Amendment Act 2006*—not exceeding \$60 000,

4—Amendment of section 29—Liability to surviving spouse of person wrongfully killed

- 15 Section 29(1)(a) and (b)—delete paragraphs (a) and (b) and substitute:

- (a) if the death occurred before the commencement of the *Civil Liability (Solatium) Amendment Act 2006*—not exceeding \$4 200; or
- 20 (b) if the death occurred after the commencement of the *Civil Liability (Solatium) Amendment Act 2006*—not exceeding \$75 000,
