Civil Liability (Trespass) Amendment Bill 2017

A BILL FOR An Act to amend the *Civil Liability Act 1936*.

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The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the Civil Liability (Trespass) Amendment Act 2017.

2—Commencement

This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

3—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

4—Insertion of Part 9 Division 12B

After section 75A insert:

Division 12B—Exclusion of liability for trespass—authorised officers

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75B—Exclusion of liability for trespass—authorised officers

- (1) No action for trespass arises by reason only of an authorised officer carrying out official duties to which this subsection applies on another person's premises.
- (2) Subsection (1) applies to the following official duties of an authorised officer:
 - (a) executing any civil or criminal process, including issuing or giving to, or serving on, a person a summons, notice or other document required or authorised to be issued or given to, or served on, the person under an Act or law;

	(b)	observing and carrying out any direction of a court.
