### 1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) (Types of Classifications) Amendment Act 2004.* 

### 5 **2—Commencement**

#### 33—Conversion of certain pre-commencement classifications to equivalent new classifications

A film that, immediately before the commencement of this Act, had a classification of (1)a type specified in column 2 of an item in the Table, is, for the purpose of applying the Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) Act 1995 after that commencement, to be taken to have, and to have had at all times before that commencement when it had that classification, the classification of the type specified opposite it in column 3 of that item.
