The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Access to Ministers) Amendment Act 2012*.

2—Amendment provisions

- 5 In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of *Constitution Act 1934*

3—Insertion of section 73C

After section 73B insert:

- 10 **73C—Offence to promote event involving special access to Minister**

A person must not promote an event intended to raise funds for a political party in a way that suggests special access will be given to a Minister at the event or in association with the event.

- 15 Maximum penalty: \$20 000.
