#### The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

# Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Access to Ministers) Amendment Act 2012.

# 2—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

#### 3—Insertion of section 73C

After section 73B insert:

# 73C—Offence to promote event involving special access to Minister

A person must not promote an event intended to raise funds for a political party in a way that suggests special access will be given to a Minister at the event or in association with the event.

Maximum penalty: \$20 000.
