89 Demise of the Crown

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Demise of the Crown) Amendment Act 2016.*

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

89—Demise of the Crown

The demise of the Sovereign—

- (a) has the effect of transferring all the functions, duties, powers, authorities, rights, privileges and dignities belonging to the Crown to the Sovereign's successor; but
- (b) has no other effect in law for any purpose.
