The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Electoral Redistribution) Amendment Act 2006*.

5 2—Commencement

The commencement of this Act is subject to the operation of the *Referendum (Electoral Redistribution) Act 2006* and, if approved at the referendum, this Act will come into operation on the day on which it is assented to by the Governor.

3—Amendment provisions

- 10 In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of *Constitution Act 1934*

4—Amendment of section 82—Electoral redistributions

- (1) Section 82(2)(a)—delete paragraph (a)
- 15 (2) Section 82(2)(c)—delete paragraph (c) and substitute:
 - (c) within 3 months after—
 - (i) the first polling day occurring after the commencement of the *Constitution (Electoral Redistribution) Amendment Act 2006*; and
 - 20 (ii) every second polling day occurring thereafter.
