## The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

## Part 1—Preliminary

## 1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Electoral Redistribution) Amendment Act 2006.* 

### 5 **2—Commencement**

The commencement of this Act is subject to the operation of the *Referendum* (*Electoral Redistribution*) *Act 2006* and, if approved at the referendum, this Act will come into operation on the day on which it is assented to by the Governor.

## 3—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

## Part 2—Amendment of Constitution Act 1934

#### 4—Amendment of section 82—Electoral redistributions

- (1) Section 82(2)(a)—delete paragraph (a)
- (2) Section 82(2)(c)—delete paragraph (c) and substitute:
  - (c) within 3 months after—
    - (i) the first polling day occurring after the commencement of the Constitution (Electoral Redistribution) Amendment Act 2006; and
    - (ii) every second polling day occurring thereafter.
