## The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

### Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Governor's Salary) Amendment Act 2015*.

#### 5 2—Commencement

This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

#### 3—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

### 10 Part 2—Amendment of *Constitution Act 1934*

#### 4—Substitution of section 73

Section 73—delete the section and substitute:

##### 73—Governor's salary

- 15 (1) The Governor is entitled to a salary at a rate determined by the Remuneration Tribunal in relation to the office of Governor.
- (2) Remuneration is not payable under this section to the Governor for any period for which he or she is entitled to remuneration from the Commonwealth in respect of his or her administration of the Government of the Commonwealth.
- 20 (3) A rate of salary determined under this section cannot be reduced by subsequent determination of the Remuneration Tribunal.
