The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Controlled Substances* (*Possession of Prescribed Equipment*) *Amendment Act* 2007.

5 **2—Commencement**

This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

3—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of Controlled Substances Act 1984

4—Insertion of section 33LA

After section 33L insert:

33LA—Possession of prescribed equipment

 A person who, without reasonable excuse (proof of which lies on the person), has possession of any prescribed equipment is guilty of an offence.

Maximum penalty: \$10 000 or imprisonment for 2 years, or both.

(2) In this section—

prescribed equipment means—

- (a) a document containing instructions for the manufacture of a controlled drug or the cultivation of a controlled plant; or
- (b) equipment of a kind prescribed by regulation.
