The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Controlled Substances (Simple Possession Offences) Amendment Act 2014.*

5 **2—Commencement**

This Act will come into operation 4 weeks after the day on which it is assented to by the Governor.

3—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of Controlled Substances Act 1984

4—Substitution of section 34

Section 34—delete the section and substitute:

34—Application of Division

This Division does not apply in relation to-

- (a) a child who is alleged to have committed a simple possession offence; or
- (b) a person who is alleged to have committed a simple possession offence and who has, on 2 or more previous occasions, been referred for assessment under this Division.
