Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Emergency Services Funding (Protection of Funds) Amendment Act 2008.*

2—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of Emergency Services Funding Act 1998

3—Amendment of section 28—Community Emergency Services Fund

Section 28—after subsection (4) insert:

(5) Money paid to an entity under subsection (4)(a) (an *emergency services entity*) or to the South Australian Fire and Emergency Services Commission under subsection (4)(b) cannot be used or applied to cover a liability of an emergency services entity or the Crown to pay damages or compensation to a person who has suffered loss or damage as a result of the act or omission of an emergency services entity.
