## The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

### Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

- 5 This Act may be cited as the *Local Government (Elections) (Disclosure of Political Affiliation) Amendment Act 2015*.

#### 2—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

#### 10 3—Amendment of section 4—Preliminary

- (1) Section 4(1)—after the definition of *officer* insert:

*parliamentary party* means a political party at least 1 member of which is—

- (a) a member of the Parliament of South Australia; or
- (b) a Senator for the State of South Australia; or
- 15 (c) a member of the House of Representatives chosen in the State of South Australia;

- (2) Section 4(1)—after the definition of *periodic election* insert:

*political party* means—

- (a) a parliamentary party; or
- 20 (b) a political party (other than a parliamentary party) whose membership includes at least 200 electors;

Section 19(2)(b)—delete paragraph (b) and substitute:
