The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Local Government (Waste Collection) Amendment Act 2013*.

2—Commencement

This Act will come into operation 1 month after the day on which it is assented to by the Governor.

3—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

4—Amendment of section 4—Interpretation

Section 4(1)—after the definition of *member* insert:

Metropolitan Adelaide has the same meaning as in the *Development Act 1993*;

metropolitan council means a council whose area is wholly or partly within Metropolitan Adelaide;

After section 297 insert:

297A—Waste collection

A metropolitan council must endeavour to ensure that a weekly general kerbside waste collection service (other than for recyclable waste or vegetative matter) is provided for residential premises within its area.
