This Act may be cited as the Oaths (Judicial Officers) Amendment Act 2004.

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

### Part 2—Amendment of Oaths Act 1936

#### 3—Amendment of section 7—Oaths to be taken by judicial officers

Section 7(1)(a) to (g)—delete paragraphs (a) to (g) and substitute:

- (a) the Chief Justice, puisne judges and Masters of the Supreme Court; and
- (b) the Chief Judge, other Judges and Masters of the District Court; and
- (c) magistrates; and
- (d) justices of the peace,

#### 4—Amendment of section 28—Commissioners for taking affidavits

- (1) Section 28(1)(b)—delete paragraph (b) and substitute:
  - (b) all Judges and Masters of the District Court; and
- (2) Section 28(1)(c)—delete "special"
