The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Security and Investigation Agents (Crowd Controller Licence Suspension) Amendment Act 2007*.

5 2—Commencement

This Act will come into operation 6 months after the day on which it is assented to by the Governor.
