The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Statutes Amendment (Prohibition on Minors Participating in Lotteries) Bill 2005*.

5 2—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of *Lottery and Gaming Act 1936*

3—Insertion of section 14BA

10 After section 14B insert:

14BA—Condition of licence that children not participate in lottery

15 It is a condition of a licence granted under the regulations for the conduct of a lottery (other than a trade-promotion lottery) that the licensee must not cause, suffer or permit a person under the age of 18 years to participate in the lottery.

4—Amendment of section 17B—Minors not to participate in lotteries

Section 17B—delete "16 years" wherever occurring and substitute in each case:

20 18 years
