The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Statutes Amendment (Prohibition on Minors Participating in Lotteries) Bill* 2006.

5 **2—Amendment provisions**

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of Lottery and Gaming Act 1936

3—Insertion of section 14BA

After section 14B insert:

14BA—Condition of licence that children not participate in lottery

It is a condition of a licence granted under the regulations for the conduct of a lottery (other than a trade-promotion lottery) that the licensee must not cause, suffer or permit a person under the age of 18 years to participate in the lottery.

4—Amendment of section 17B—Minors not to participate in lotteries
