The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Statutes Amendment (Surrogacy) Amendment Act 2010*.

2—Commencement

This Act will come into operation immediately after the *Statutes Amendment* (Surrogacy) Act 2009 comes into operation.

3—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of Statutes Amendment (Surrogacy) Act 2009

4—Amendment of Schedule 1—Transitional provisions

Schedule 1, clause 1(4)—delete subclause (4) and substitute:

(4) An application cannot be made under this clause if a child has been born as a result of the relevant pregnancy and the child is more than 10 years old on the day on which the *Statutes Amendment* (Surrogacy) Amendment Act 2010 comes into operation.
