**The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:**

## **Part 1—Preliminary**

### **1—Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Statutes Amendment (Terrorism) Act 2015*.

### **5 2—Amendment provisions**

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

## **Part 2—Amendment of *Terrorism (Police Powers) Act 2005***

### **2A—Amendment of section 30—Review of Act**

- 10 (1) Section 30(1)—after paragraph (b) insert:

- (c) the twelfth anniversary of the commencement of this Act; and
- (d) the fourteenth anniversary of the commencement of this Act; and
- (e) the sixteenth anniversary of the commencement of this Act; and
- (f) the eighteenth anniversary of the commencement of this Act.

- 15 (2) Section 30—after subsection (1) insert:

- (1a) The Minister must, within the 4-month period preceding the expiry of this Act, cause the operation of this Act to be finally reviewed.

### **3—Amendment of section 31—Expiry of Act**

Section 31—delete "tenth" and substitute:

- 20 twentieth

## **Part 3—Amendment of *Terrorism (Preventative Detention) Act 2005***

### **4—Amendment of section 52—Sunset provision**

Section 52—delete "10" wherever occurring and substitute in each case:

### **5—Transitional provision**

Section 52 of the *Terrorism (Preventative Detention) Act 2005*, as amended by Part 3 of this Act, applies in relation to a preventative detention order or prohibited contact order whether the order was made before or after the commencement of Part 3.
