The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Subordinate Legislation (Disallowance) Amendment Act* 2020.

2—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of Subordinate Legislation Act 1978

3—Insertion of section 10AAA

After section 10 insert:

10AAA—Remaking disallowed regulations

- (1) A regulation (the *later regulation*) that is the same in substance as another regulation (the *disallowed regulation*) that has been disallowed by a resolution of either House of Parliament may not be made within the period of 6 months after the day of disallowance.
- (2) However, the later regulation may be made within that period if the House of the Parliament that passed the resolution to disallow the disallowed regulation approves, by resolution, the making of a regulation that is the same in substance as the disallowed regulation.
- (3) A regulation made in contravention of this section is of no effect.
