The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *The Standard Time (Eastern Standard Time) Amendment Act 2004*.

5 2—Commencement

This Act will come into operation on a day and at a time to be fixed by proclamation.

15 Standard time in South Australia is the mean time of the meridian of longitude 150 degrees east of Greenwich in England.
