#### The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

# Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

This Act may be cited as *The Standard Time (True Central Standard Time) Amendment Act 2005.* 

#### 5 **2—Commencement**

This Act will come into operation at 2 a.m. on 27 March 2005.
