## The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

### Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

5 This Act may be cited as the *Youth Justice Administration (Functions of Training Centre Visitor) Amendment Act 2019*.

#### 2—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

### Part 2—Amendment of *Youth Justice Administration Act 2016*

#### 10 3—Insertion of section 11A

After section 11 insert:

##### 11A—Delegation

- 15 (1) The Training Centre Visitor may, by instrument in writing, delegate any powers, duties or functions under this Act to any person.
- (2) A delegation under this section—
  - (a) may be absolute or conditional; and
  - (b) does not derogate from the power of the Visitor to act personally in any matter; and
  - (c) is revocable at will; and
  - 20 (d) may, if the instrument of delegation so provides, be further delegated.

**4—Amendment of section 14—Training Centre Visitor's functions**

Section 14—after subsection (3) insert:

- (4) The Visitor may exercise functions under this Part in respect of a resident of a training centre whether the resident is within, or outside, the precincts of a training centre in which they are being detained, or are to be detained.
