The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

5 This Act may be cited as the *Local Government (Elections) (Display and Publication of Valid Nominations) Amendment Act 2023*.

Part 2—Amendment of *Local Government (Elections) Act 1999*

2—Substitution of section 21

Section 21—delete the section and substitute:

21—Display and publication etc of valid nominations

- 10 (1) The returning officer must, as soon as practicable after the receipt of a valid nomination—
- 15 (a) cause a copy of the nomination to be displayed in the principal office of the council in respect of which the nomination was made; and
- (b) publish a copy of the nomination on the Internet.
- (2) The returning officer must, within 24 hours after the close of nominations—
- 20 (a) provide a council with a list of all valid nominations relevant to the council's area; and
- (b) publish a list of all valid nominations on the Internet.
