## Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Committees (Response to Reports)*Amendment Act 2024.

# 2—Amendment of section 19—Reference of Committee report to Minister for response

- (1) Section 19(1) and (1a)—delete subsections (1) and (1a) and substitute:
  - (1) On a report being presented by a Committee to its appointing House or Houses, the report is referred by force of this section to the Minister with primary responsibility in the area concerned for that Minister's response.
- (2) Section 19(4)—before the definition of *prescribed Minister* insert:

#### appointing House or Houses means—

- (a) in relation to a Committee established under this Act—the Committee's appointing House or Houses as defined in section 3; or
- (b) in relation to any other Committee—the House that appointed the Committee or, in the case of a joint Committee, both Houses;

*Committee* means a Committee established under this Act or a Committee referred to in section 36;
