## The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

### Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

- 5 This Act may be cited as the *Return to Work Corporation of South Australia (Constitution of Board) Amendment Act 2022*.

#### 2—Commencement

This Act comes into operation 3 months after it is assented to by the Governor.

### Part 2—Amendment of *Return to Work Corporation of South Australia Act 1994*

#### 10 3—Amendment of section 5—Constitution of board of management

- (1) Section 5(2)—delete subsection (2) and substitute:
  - (2) The board consists of 9 members appointed by the Governor of whom—
    - (a) 3 must be nominated by the Minister; and
    - 15 (b) 3 must be nominated by the Minister after consulting with associations representing the interests of employees; and
    - (c) 3 must be nominated by the Minister after consulting with associations representing the interests of employers.

- (2) Section 5(3)—delete "3" wherever occurring and substitute in each case:
  - 20 4

#### 4—Amendment of section 11—Proceedings

Section 11(1)—delete "4" and substitute:

**5—Amendment of Schedule—Transitional provisions**

Schedule—after clause 1 insert:

**2—Board of management**
