This Act may be cited as the Statutes Amendment (Ombudsman and Auditor-General) (Terms of Office) Act 2023.

## Part 2—Amendment of Ombudsman Act 1972

## 2—Amendment of section 10—Term of office of the Ombudsman etc

(1) Section 10(1)—delete "expiring on the day on which he or she attains the age of 65 years" and substitute:

not exceeding 7 years

- (2) Section 10—after subsection (1) insert:
  - (1a) A person appointed to be the Ombudsman is, at the end of a term of appointment, eligible for reappointment but cannot hold office for terms (including any term as Acting Ombudsman) that exceed 10 years in total.
- (3) Section 10(4)(b)—delete paragraph (b) and substitute:
  - (b) completes a term of office and is not reappointed; or

# 3—Amendment of section 24—Appointment of Auditor-General

(1) Section 24(2)—after "Governor" insert:

for a term not exceeding 7 years

- (2) Section 24—after subsection (2) insert:
  - (2a) A person appointed to be the Auditor-General is, at the end of a term of appointment, eligible for reappointment but cannot hold office for terms (including any period acting in the office of Auditor-General) that exceed 10 years in total.

## 4—Amendment of section 27—Vacation of office of Auditor-General

Section 27(c)—delete paragraph (c) and substitute:

(c) completes a term of office and is not reappointed;

- (1) The amendments to the *Ombudsman Act 1972* effected by Part 2 of this Act do not apply to the person holding office as Ombudsman on the commencement of this Act.
- (2) The amendments to the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1987* effected by Part 3 of this Act do not apply to the person holding office as Auditor-General on the commencement of this Act.
