Local Government (Defaulting Council) Proclamation 2019

under section 273 of the Local Government Act 1999

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Local Government (Defaulting Council) Proclamation 2019.*

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Interpretation

In this proclamation, unless the contrary intention appears—

Act means the Local Government Act 1999;

Council means the District Council of Coober Pedy.

4—Defaulting council

The Council is declared to be a defaulting council.

5—Appointment of administrator

Timothy Robert Sandford Jackson is appointed to be the administrator of the affairs of the Council.

6—Application of provisions of Acts and regulations

- (1) Subject to this clause, the provisions of the Act (including regulations made under those provisions) and the *Local Government (Elections) Act 1999* are declared to apply while the Council is a defaulting council, subject to the exclusions and modifications set out in Schedule 1.
- (2) The *Local Government (Procedures at Meetings) Regulations 2013* do not apply while the Council is a defaulting council.
