## Local Government (Defaulting Council) Proclamation 2019

under section 273 of the *Local Government Act 1999*

### 1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Local Government (Defaulting Council) Proclamation 2019*.

### 3—Interpretation

In this proclamation, unless the contrary intention appears—

*Act* means the *Local Government Act 1999*;

*Council* means the District Council of Coober Pedy.

### 4—Defaulting council

The Council is declared to be a defaulting council.

### 5—Appointment of administrator

Colin John Davies is appointed to be the administrator of the affairs of the Council.

### 6—Application of provisions of Acts and regulations

- (1) Subject to this clause, the provisions of the Act (including regulations made under those provisions), the *Local Government (Elections) Act 1999* and the *Public Sector Act 2009* are declared to apply while the Council is a defaulting council, subject to the exclusions and modifications set out in Schedule 1.
- (2) The *Local Government (Procedures at Meetings) Regulations 2013* do not apply while the Council is a defaulting council.

nominated in writing by the chief executive officer) makes available to the public a live stream of the meeting on a website determined by the chief executive officer and ensures that members of the public can hear via the live stream the administrator and any person invited by the administrator to speak at the meeting; or

- (b) if the chief executive officer (or a person nominated in writing by the chief executive officer) has taken reasonable steps to make available a live stream of the meeting but is unable to make available a live stream of the meeting, the chief executive officer (or a person nominated in writing by the chief executive officer) makes available to the public a recording of the meeting as soon as practicable after the meeting on a website determined by the chief executive officer and ensures that members of the public can hear via the recording the administrator and any person invited by the administrator to speak at the meeting.

- (1b) If the chief executive officer (or a person nominated in writing by the chief executive officer) has taken reasonable steps to comply with subsection (1a) but is unable to comply—

- (a) the chief executive officer (or a person nominated in writing by the chief executive officer) must publish on a website determined by the chief executive officer the steps taken to comply with subsection (1a); and
- (b) subsections (1) and (1a) are suspended.
