Youth Court (Designation and Classification of Magistrates) Proclamation 2006

under section 9 of the *Youth Court Act 1993*

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Youth Court (Designation and Classification of Magistrates) Proclamation 2006*.

3—Interpretation

In this proclamation—

Act means the *Youth Court Act 1993*;

Court means the Youth Court of South Australia.

4—Revocation of certain proclamations previously made under section 9 of Act

All proclamations previously made under section 9 of the Act that—

- (a) designated a Magistrate as a Magistrate of the Court; and
- (b) classified the Magistrate of the Court as a member of the Court's ancillary judiciary,

are revoked.

5—Designation and classification of Magistrates

- (1) A Stipendiary Magistrate named in Schedule 1 is—
 - (a) designated as a Magistrate of the Court; and
 - (b) classified as a member of the Court's ancillary judiciary.
- (2) An auxiliary Magistrate named in Schedule 1 is—
 - (a) designated as a Magistrate of the Court; and
 - (b) classified as a member of the Court's ancillary judiciary.
