Bills of Sale (Requirements as to Instruments) Regulations 1995

under the *Bills of Sale Act 1886*

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Legislative history

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Bills of Sale (Requirements as to Instruments) Regulations 1995*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 September 1995.

3—Revocation

The *Bills of Sale Act (Paper for Instruments) Regulations 1984* (see *Gazette* 22.3.1984 p737) are revoked.

4—Requirements relating to paper used for Bills of Sale etc

The following requirements are prescribed under section 38A of the *Bills of Sale Act 1886* in relation to the paper on which bills of sale and other instruments lodged with the Registrar for registration or filing under that Act are written:

- (a) the paper must be A4 size (210 millimetres in width and 297 millimetres in length); and
- (b) the weight of the paper must be at least 80 grams per square metre; and
- (c) the paper must not be discoloured or have any other defect.
