REGULATIONS UNDER THE BOATING ACT 1974

Boating (Port Stanvac Zoning) Regulations 1992

being

No. 127 of 1992: *Gaz.* 25 June 1992, p. 1981

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Boating (Port Stanvac Zoning) Regulations 1992*.

Revocation

2. The *Port Stanvac Zoning Regulations 1983* (see *Gazette* 15 December 1983 p 1684) are revoked.

Interpretation

3. In these regulations—

"**controlled area no. 1**" means that portion of the sea at Port Stanvac delineated on the plan in the schedule as controlled area no. 1;

"**controlled area no. 2**" means that portion of the sea at Port Stanvac delineated on the plan in the schedule as controlled area no. 2.

Note: For definition of divisional penalties see Appendix.

Boats prohibited in controlled areas

4. A person who—

(a) takes a boat into controlled area no. 1 or controlled area no. 2;

or

(b) causes or permits a boat to enter controlled area no. 1 or controlled area no. 2,

is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: Division 10 fine.

Divisional Penalties

At the date of publication of this reprint divisional penalties are, as provided by section 28a of the *Acts Interpretation Act, 1915*, as follows:

Division	Maximum imprisonment	Maximum fine
1	15 years	\$60 000
2	10 years	\$40 000
3	7 years	\$30 000
4	4 years	\$15 000
5	2 years	\$8 000
6	1 year	\$4 000
7	6 months	\$2 000
8	3 months	\$1 000
9	-	\$500
10	-	\$200
11	-	\$100
12	-	\$50
