Boating (Stansbury Zoning) Regulations 1992

being

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Boating (Stansbury Zoning) Regulations 1992*.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations—

"**controlled area 1**" means that portion of the waters of the sea at Stansbury delineated on the plan in the schedule as controlled area 1:

"**controlled area 2**" means that portion of the waters of the sea at Stansbury delineated on the plan in the schedule as controlled area 2.

Note: For definition of divisional penalties see Appendix 2.

Speed limit in controlled areas 1 and 2

3. A person who, within controlled area 1 or controlled area 2—

(a) operates a vessel at a speed exceeding eight kilometres per hour;

or

(b) engages in water-skiing, aquaplaning or is towed in any other manner at a speed exceeding eight kilometres per hour,

is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: Division 10 fine.

At the date of publication of this reprint divisional penalties are, as provided by section 28a of the *Acts Interpretation Act, 1915*, as follows:

6	1 year	\$4 000

11	-	\$100
12	-	\$50
