### Legislative history

---

#### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Courts Administration Regulations 1993*.

#### 2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 July 1993.

#### 3—Interpretation

In these regulations—

*the Act* means the *Courts Administration Act 1993*.

#### 4—Participating courts

- (1) For the purposes of the definition of *participating courts* in section 4 of the Act, each of the following courts is declared to be a participating court:
  - (a) Court of Disputed Returns established under the *Local Government Act 1934*;
  - (b) Warden's Court.
- (2) For the purposes of the definition of *participating courts* in section 4 of the Act, each of the following tribunals is declared to be a participating court:
  - (a) Air Pollution Appeal Tribunal;
  - (b) Business Franchise Petroleum Appeal Tribunal;
  - (c) City of Adelaide Planning Appeals Tribunal;
  - (d) Dental Professional Conduct Tribunal;
  - (e) Equal Opportunity Tribunal;
  - (f) Legal Practitioners Disciplinary Tribunal;
  - (g) Medical Practitioners Professional Conduct Tribunal;

- (h) Motor Fuel Licensing Appeal Tribunal;
- (i) Pastoral Land Appeal Tribunal;
- (j) Planning Appeal Tribunal;
- (k) Police Disciplinary Tribunal;
- (l) Soil Conservation Appeal Tribunal;
- (m) the appellate Tribunal established under the *Tobacco Products (Licensing) Act 1986*;
- (n) Towtruck Tribunal;
- (o) Water Resources Appeal Tribunal.

### **5—Prescribed position**

For the purposes of the definition of *prescribed position* in section 4 of the Act, each of the following positions on the staff of the Council is designated as a prescribed position:

- (a) Deputy State Court Administrator;
- (b) Registrar Supreme Court;
- (c) Registrar District Court;
- (d) Registrar Magistrates Court;
- (e) Registrar of Probates;
- (f) Sheriff.

### **6—Council may not incur contractual liabilities exceeding limit**

For the purposes of section 11(2)(a) of the Act, the limit is \$1 000 000.
