Legislative history

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Fees Regulation (Stock Medicines) Regulations 1992*.

2—Revocation

The *Stock Medicines (Fees) Regulations 1987* (see *Gazette 18.6.1987 p1581*) are revoked.

3—Interpretation

In these regulations—
the Act means the *Stock Medicines Act 1939*.

4—Variation of fees: section 7(3a)

- (1) The fee fixed by section 7(3a)(a) of the Act is varied by removing the fee.
- (2) The fee fixed by section 7(3a)(b) of the Act is varied by removing the fee.
- (3) The fee fixed by section 7(3a)(c) of the Act is varied by removing the fee.
