1. These regulations may be cited as the *Health Commission (Prescribed Health Service) Regulations, 1987*.

2. In these regulations:

"Act" means the *South Australian Health Commission Act, 1976*.

**Prescribed services**

3. Pursuant to paragraph (d) of the definition of "**health service**" in section 6 of the Act, the following services are prescribed:

- (a) the provision of linen and laundry services to hospitals or other health care providers;
- (b) the allocation of resources between incorporated hospitals and incorporated health centres.
