Legislative history

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Poultry Meat Industry Regulations 1996*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 September 1996.

3—Revocation

All regulations previously made under the *Poultry Meat Industry Act 1969* are revoked.

4—Interpretation

In these regulations—

Act means the *Poultry Meat Industry Act 1969*.

5—Form of application for approval

For the purposes of section 11I(2) of the Act, an application for approval of a farm or proposed farm or for approval to operate a farm or proposed farm must—

- (a) contain the particulars required by Form 1 of the Schedule; and
- (b) be accompanied by the fee of \$10.

6—Form of certificate of approval

For the purposes of section 11I(6) of the Act, a certificate of approval must be in the following form:

- (a) if approval is granted to the operator or proposed operator of a farm or proposed farm—Form 2 of the Schedule;

- (b) if approval is granted to the operator of plant to operate a farm or proposed farm—Form 3 of the Schedule.

This application must be accompanied by the prescribed fee of \$10.

Under the *Poultry Meat Industry Act 1969*—

farm means any place or premises used for raising chickens for processing at a plant; and

plant means any place or premises used for processing and includes any place or premises used for any stage of processing.
