APPENDIX LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Public and Environmental Health (Notifiable Diseases) Regulations, 1989*.

Commencement

2. These regulations will come into operation on 7 December, 1989.

Interpretation

3. In these regulations—

"the Act" means the *Public and Environmental Health Act, 1987*.

Notification of diseases

4. * * * * *

(2) For the purposes of section 30(1) and (4) of the Act, persons who are in charge of pathology laboratories are a prescribed class.

Presumption of diseases

5. (1) The following diseases are prescribed as notifiable diseases for the purposes of the Act:

- Anthrax*
- Chlamydia Infection*
- Donovanosis*
- Haemolytic-uraemic Syndrome (HUS)*
- Human Immunodeficiency Virus*
- Infection caused by E.Coli capable of producing Shiga toxin*
- Invasive Pneumococcal Disease*
- Legionellosis*
- Lyssavirus Infection*
- Varicella-Zoster Infection.*

(2) The following diseases are prescribed as controlled notifiable diseases for the purposes of the Act:

- Human Immunodeficiency Virus*
- Lyssavirus Infection.*
