Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Section 471 Hospitals) Regulations 1992.

Commencement

2. These regulations will come into operation on 1 September 1992.

Revocation

3. The *Road Traffic (Blood Analysis) Regulations 1973* (see *Gazette 19 July 1973 p. 299)*, as varied, are revoked.

Interpretation

4. In these regulations—

"the Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1961.
