Legislative history

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *South Australian Health Commission (Prescribed Health Service) Regulations 2002*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 September 2002.

3—Revocation

The *Health Commission (Prescribed Health Service) Regulations 1987* (see *Gazette 20.8.1987 p592*), as varied, are revoked.

4—Interpretation

In these regulations—

Act means the *South Australian Health Commission Act 1976*.

5—Prescribed services

The following services are prescribed for the purposes of paragraph (d) of the definition of *health service* in section 6 of the Act:

- (a) the provision of linen and laundry services to hospitals or other health care providers;
- (b) the allocation of resources between incorporated hospitals and incorporated health centres.
