### Legislative history

#### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Summary Procedure (Restraining Orders) Regulations 1994*.

#### 2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 August 1994.

#### 3—Revocation

The *Summary Procedure (Summary Protection Orders) Regulations 1993* (see *Gazette* 25.2.1993 p729) are revoked.

#### 4—Interpretation

In these regulations—

*the Act* means the *Summary Procedure Act 1921*.

#### 5—Foreign restraining orders

For the purposes of the definition of a *foreign restraining order* in section 4 of the Act, the following laws are declared to be laws corresponding to Part 4 Division 7 of the Act:
