Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Superannuation Funds Management Corporation of South Australia (Prescribed Public Authorities) Regulations 1995*.

3—Interpretation

In these regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—

the Act means the *Superannuation Funds Management Corporation of South Australia Act 1995*.

Part 3—General

18—Prescribed public authorities

For the purposes of the definition of *prescribed public authority* in section 3(1) of the Act, the following are declared to be prescribed public authorities:

- (a) Adelaide Cemeteries Authority;
- (b) South Australian Government Financing Authority;
- (c) Public Trustee;
- (d) Motor Accident Commission.
