Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Trade Measurement (Administration) Regulations 1993*.

Commencement

2. These regulations will come into operation on 1 October 1993.

Interpretation

3. In these regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—

"**certificate of suitability**", in relation to a weighbridge, means a certificate issued by the administering authority for the purposes of section 50(1)(a) of the principal Act to the effect that the weighbridge is suitable for use as a public weighbridge;

"**the Act**" means the *Trade Measurement Administration Act 1993*.

Fees and charges

4. (1) The fees and charges set out in the schedules to these regulations are payable as specified in those schedules for the purposes of the Act and the principal Act.

(2) The periodic licence fee prescribed under schedule 1 for the purposes of section 52(1) of the principal Act must be paid for each year during which the licence is in force or is under suspension.

(3) Pursuant to section 9(4) of the Act, if a charge (or part of a charge) payable under schedule 2, 3 or 4 is outstanding for 28 days after the day on which the administering authority requires payment by the person liable to pay the charge under the relevant schedule, a penalty of 10 per cent of the outstanding amount is imposed.

Transitional provision

5. (1) A person who was, immediately before the commencement of these regulations, registered under the repealed regulations as the principal in a business of repairing or adjusting measuring instruments used for, or for use for, trade will be taken to be the holder of a servicing licence under the principal Act until 1 February 1994 (when the licence will expire).

(2) A mark used by a person referred to under subregulation (1) for the purposes of the repealed regulations will be taken to be an approved mark under section 46 of the principal Act.

(3) A person who was, immediately before the commencement of these regulations, the owner of a registered public weighbridge under the repealed regulations will be taken to be the holder of a public weighbridge licence under the principal Act until 1 March 1994 (when the licence will expire).

(4) Without limiting the operation of any condition imposed under the principal Act, a condition that applied to a registration under the repealed regulations immediately before the commencement of these regulations will be taken to apply with respect to a licence that is taken to exist by virtue of these regulations.

(5) In this regulation—

"**the repealed regulations**" means the *Weights and Measures Regulations 1972*.

SCHEDULE 4

*Charges Payable where Inspector Keeps Appointment but Measuring Instrument
Unavailable for Examination or Testing*

The charges set out in this Schedule are payable to the administering authority by the owner of an instrument when an inspector keeps an appointment to examine or test the instrument but the instrument is unavailable for examination or testing.

1. Where a test on a measuring instrument involves the use of the weighbridge testing unit—
for each 15 minutes or part of 15 minutes that the inspector is kept waiting \$55

2. Where a test on a measuring instrument does not involve the use of the weighbridge testing unit—
for each 15 minutes or part of 15 minutes that the inspector is kept waiting \$25
